**Release and Waiver of Liability**

The undersigned volunteer ("Volunteer") understands and agrees that he/she is not an employee of LCCC and is not entitled to any wages and/or benefits associated with his/her volunteered labor or services. Volunteer acknowledges and understands that the activities include work that may be hazardous to the Volunteer, including but not limited to, construction, hauling, loading and unloading, and transportation to and from the work sites.

Volunteer further agrees, on behalf of himself/herself and on behalf of his/her heirs, assigns, trustees, receivers, administrators, executors and agents to release and forever discharge LCCC, their directors, officers, employees, agents, other volunteers, members, and all other persons or entities whomsoever (individually and as a group defined as "the Club") from any and all actions, claims, and demands, known or unknown, which Volunteer has or may have in the future arising out of volunteering for LCCC. Additionally, Volunteer specifically releases any subrogation rights that might arise.

## Release and Waiver of Liability -- continued

Volunteer understands that this Release discharges the Club for any liability or claim that the Volunteer may have against the Club with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death or property damage that may result from Volunteer's activities with LCCC whether caused by the negligence of the Club. Volunteer understands that LCCC does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.

Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharges and holds harmless the Club and any successors and assigns from any liability or claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's activities with LCCC.

**The undersigned acknowledges that he/she has read this Release and understands that this Release may be pled as a complete bar and defense to any action or other proceedings instituted or filed by Volunteer on account of any matter contained herein.**

Volunteer expressly agrees that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of Wisconsin and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of Wisconsin. Volunteer agrees that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Release which shall continue to be enforceable.

Volunteer agrees to follow all safety instructions provided by the Golf Course Superintendant or his Assistant.

## Safety Addendum

LCCC strives to make your volunteer experience both enjoyable and rewarding. Following the guidelines below will help to ensure everyone has a safe and meaningful experience.

- **Let the Golf Course Superintendant know** if you need to leave early for any reason.
